EPHESIANS 6:10-11

“Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. Put on the full armor of God so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes”.

Schemes = tricks by lying

Armor of God

Just like a soldier does not go to battle unless he is fully covered and armed, we must take up the full armor to stand firm in the strength of the Lord from the Word of God.

Ephesians 6:13

Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be **able to stand your ground...**

6 PARTS OF OUR SPIRITUAL ARMOR.



Ephesians 6:17 a

Take the **helmet of salvation**



Ephesians 6:14 b

with the **breastplate of righteousness** in place.



Ephesians 6:14 a

Stand firm, with the **belt of truth** buckled around your waist,



Ephesians 6:17 b

and the **sword of the Spirit**, which is the word of God.



Ephesians 6:16

In addition to all this, take up the **shield of faith**, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one.



Ephesians 6:15

and with your **feet** fitted with the readiness that comes from the **gospel of peace**.

Armor of God

Match the piece of armor with the area of the body it protects on a soldier of Christ:

Belt of Truth	Feet
Breastplate of Righteousness	Head
Shoes of Peace	Hand
Shield of Faith	Front of whole Body
Helmet of Salvation	Waist
Sword of the Spirit (Bible)	Chest

Ephesians 6:18
