The Bible is God's Word	
Jeremiah 10:10a - But the <u>LORD</u> is the true <u>God</u> ; He is the living <u>God</u> . John 17:17b - Your <u>word</u> is <u>truth</u> Psalms 119:42b - I <u>trust</u> in Your word.	1:1
God says His Word is pure.	
Proverbs 30:5-6 Every <u>word</u> of God is pure; He is a <u>shield</u> to those who put their <u>trust</u> in Him. Do not add to His <u>words</u> , lest He <u>rebuke</u> you and you be found a <u>liar</u> .	1:3
People witnessed the events of the Bible.	
2 Peter 1:16 – For we did not follow cunningly <u>devised</u> <u>fables</u> when we made known to you the <u>power</u> and coming of our Lord <u>Jesus Christ</u> , but were <u>eyewitnesses</u> of His <u>majesty</u> .	1:4
The Bible is historically correct.	
1 John 1:1 - That which was from the beginning <u>Christ</u> , which we have <u>heard</u> , which we have seen with our <u>eyes</u> , which we have looked upon and our <u>hands</u> have handled, concerning the <u>Word</u> of life.	1:6

How Do We Know the Bible is True?

God used at least <u>40</u> men to write the Bible – and yet it all fits together.	
Luke 1:1-2 – Inasmuch as many have taken in <u>hand</u> to set in order a <u>narrative</u> of those things which have been <u>fulfilled</u> among us. Just as those who from the <u>beginning</u> were <u>eyewitnesses</u> and <u>ministers</u> of the word delivered them to us.	2:2
The Bible was written over a time period of <u>1,500</u> years and yet it all fits together.	
2 Peter 1:21 - For <u>prophecy</u> never came by the <u>will</u> of man, but <u>holy men</u> of God <u>spoke</u> as they were <u>moved</u> by the Holy Spirit.	2:3
Events that were prophesied really happened.	
Deuteronomy 18:22 – When a <u>prophet</u> speaks in the name of the <u>LORD</u> , if the thing does not happen or come to <u>pass</u> , that is the thing which the LORD has not spoken; the prophet has <u>spoken</u> it presumptuously; you shall not be <u>afraid</u> of him.	2:4
The Bible changes people's lives.	
Acts 16:29-31 - Then he called for a light, ran in, and <u>fell down</u> <u>trembling</u> before Paul and Silas. And he brought them out and said, "Sirs, what must I do to be <u>saved</u> ?" So they said, "Believe on the Lord <u>Jesus Christ</u> , and you will be <u>saved</u> , you and your <u>household</u> ."	2:6

Green Book UC1 Challenge 3

What do I need to know about God?

God offers me the ultimate gift	
Ephesians 2:8-10 – For by <u>grace</u> you have been <u>saved</u> through faith, and that not of yourselves, it is the <u>gift</u> of God. Not of <u>works</u> , lest anyone should <u>boast</u> .	3:2
God wants me to honor Him.	
Exodus 20:3-4 – You shall have no other <u>gods</u> before Me. You shall not make for yourself a carved <u>image</u> - any likeness of anything that is in <u>heaven</u> above or that is in the earth <u>beneath</u> or that is in the <u>water</u> under the <u>earth</u> .	3:4
Exodus 20:5a – You shall not <u>bow down</u> to them nor <u>serve</u> them.	
Exodus 20:7a, 8 – You shall not <u>take</u> the name of the LORD your God in <u>vain</u> . Remember the <u>Sabbath</u> day, to keep it <u>holy</u> .	
God wants me to honor my family and neighbors.	
Exodus 20:12-15 – <u>Honor</u> your father and your mother, that your days may be <u>long</u> upon the land which the LORD your <u>God</u> is giving you. You shall not <u>murder</u> . You shall not commit adultery. You shall not <u>steal</u> .	3:5
Exodus 20:16-17 – You shall not bear <u>false</u> witness against your neighbor. You shall not covet your neighbor's <u>house</u> . You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his male <u>servant</u> nor his female <u>servant</u> , nor his ox, nor his <u>donkey</u> , nor anything that is your neighbor's.	
God is merciful.	
Titus 3:5 – Not by works of <u>righteousness</u> which we have done, but according to His mercy He <u>saved</u> us, through the <u>washing</u> of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit.	3:6

Green Book UC1 Challenge 4

What do I need to know about God?

God is faithful.	
1 Corinthians 1:9 – God is <u>faithful</u> , by whom you were <u>called</u> into the <u>fellowship</u> of His <u>Son</u> , Jesus <u>Christ</u> our Lord.	4:2
God loves the world.	
John 5:24 – Most <u>assuredly</u> , I say to you, he who <u>hears</u> My word and <u>believes</u> in Him who sent Me has <u>everlasting</u> life, and shall not come into <u>judgment</u> , but has passed from death into life.	4:3
God is my authority.	
Matthew 28:18 – And <u>Jesus</u> came and spoke to them, saying, “All <u>authority</u> has been given to Me in <u>heaven</u> and on <u>earth</u> .”	4:5
God cares about me.	
Luke 12:6-7 – Are not five <u>sparrows</u> sold for two <u>copper coins</u> ? And not one of them is <u>forgotten</u> before God. But the very <u>hairs</u> of your head are all numbered. Do not <u>fear</u> therefore; you are of more value than many <u>sparrows</u> .	4:6

What do I need to know about the Lord Jesus Christ ?

Christ became a <u>man</u> so He could do what <u>God</u> had <u>planned</u>	
Matthew 1:21 And she will bring forth a <u>Son</u> , and you shall <u>call</u> His name <u>Jesus</u> , for He will <u>save</u> His people from their <u>sins</u> .	5:2
Because of the <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u>, I am <u>loved</u>	
Romans 5:8 But God <u>demonstrates</u> His own <u>love</u> for us, in that while we were still <u>sinners</u> , Christ <u>died</u> for us.	5:3
Because of the <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u>, I can have <u>salvation</u>	
Romans 4:5 But to him who does not <u>work</u> but <u>believes</u> on Him who <u>justifies</u> the ungodly, his faith is <u>accounted</u> for <u>righteousness</u> .	5:4
Because of the <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u>, I am <u>forgiven</u>	
Ephesians 1:7 In Him we have <u>redemption</u> through His blood, the <u>forgiveness</u> of sins, according to the <u>riches</u> of His <u>grace</u> .	5:6
1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and <u>just</u> to <u>forgive</u> us our sins and to <u>cleanse</u> us from all <u>unrighteousness</u> .

What do I need to know about the Lord Jesus Christ ?

Because of the <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u>, I am <u>justified</u>	
Titus 3:7 That having been <u>justified</u> by His <u>grace</u> we should become heirs according to the hope of eternal life.	6:1
Romans 3:24 Being <u>justified</u> freely by His <u>grace</u> through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus.	
I have been <u>redeemed</u> by the <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u>	
1 Peter 1:18-19 Knowing that you were not <u>redeemed</u> with corruptible things, like <u>silver</u> or <u>gold</u> , from your <u>aimless</u> conduct received by tradition from your fathers. But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a <u>lamb</u> without blemish and without spot.	6:2
I have <u>peace</u> through the <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u>	
Colossians 1:20 And by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on <u>earth</u> or things in <u>heaven</u> , having made <u>peace</u> through the blood of His cross.	6:4
Philippians 4:7 And the <u>peace</u> of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.	
The <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> is my <u>example</u>	
1 Peter 2:21 For to this you were <u>called</u> , because <u>Christ</u> also suffered for us, leaving us an <u>example</u> , that you should <u>follow</u> His <u>steps</u> .	6:5

What do I need to know about the Holy Spirit?

I am <u>baptized</u> by the Holy <u>S</u> Spirit	
Colossians 2:12 Buried with Him in <u>baptism</u> , in which you also were <u>raised</u> with Him through faith in the working of <u>God</u> , who <u>raised</u> Him from the <u>dead</u> .	7: 2
I need to know what it means to be <u>filled</u> with the <u>Spirit</u>	
Galatians 5:16 I say then: <u>Walk</u> in the <u>Spirit</u> , and you shall not fulfill the lust of the <u>flesh</u> .	7:3
The Holy <u>Spirit</u> helps me <u>pray</u>	
Romans 8:26 Likewise the <u>Spirit</u> also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should <u>pray</u> for as we ought, but the <u>Spirit</u> Himself makes intercession for us with <u>groanings</u> which cannot be <u>uttered</u> .	7:4
I am <u>sealed</u> by the Holy <u>Spirit</u>	
Ephesians 4:30 And do not <u>grieve</u> the Holy <u>Spirit</u> of God, by whom you were <u>sealed</u> for the day of <u>redemption</u> .	7:5

What do I need to know about the Holy Spirit?

The Holy <u>Spirit</u> is the guarantee of my salvation	
Ephesians 1:14 Who is the guarantee of our <u>inheritance</u> until the redemption of the <u>purchased</u> possession, to the <u>praise</u> of His Glory.	8:1
The fruit of the <u>Spirit</u>: love, joy, <u>peace</u>	
Galatians 5:22-23 But the <u>fruit</u> of the <u>Spirit</u> is <u>love</u> , joy, <u>peace</u> , longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness. <u>gentleness</u> , self-control. Against such there is no law.	8:3
The fruit of the <u>Spirit</u>: longsuffering, kindness, goodness	
Ephesians 4:1-3 I, therefore, the <u>prisoner</u> of the Lord, beseech you to <u>walk</u> worthy of the <u>calling</u> with which you were <u>called</u> . With all lowliness and <u>gentleness</u> , with longsuffering, bearing with one another in <u>love</u> . Endeavoring to keep the unity of the <u>Spirit</u> in the bond of <u>peace</u> .	8:4
The fruit of the <u>Spirit</u>: faithfulness, gentleness, self-control	
2 Peter 1:5-7 But also for this very reason, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue, to virtue <u>knowledge</u> . To <u>knowledge</u> self-control, to self-control perseverance, to perseverance <u>godliness</u> . To <u>godliness</u> brotherly kindness, and to brotherly kindness <u>love</u> .	8:5
