<p><b>Deuteronomy 5:16</b> – Honor your <u>father</u> and your <u>mother</u>, as the <u>LORD</u> your <u>God</u> has commanded you, that your <u>days</u> may be long, and that it may be <u>well</u> with you in the <u>land</u> which the <u>LORD</u> your <u>God</u> is giving you.</p> <p><b>Psalms 127:3</b> – <u>Behold</u>, <u>children</u> are a heritage from the <u>LORD</u>, the fruit of the <u>womb</u> is a <u>reward</u>.</p>	<p>1:3</p>
<p><b>Family members should talk to one another.</b></p>	
<p><b>Proverbs 4:2-4</b> – For I give you good <u>doctrine</u>: do not forsake my <u>law</u>. When I was my <u>father's son</u>, tender and the only one in the sight of my <u>mother</u>. He also <u>taught</u> me, and said to me: "Let your <u>heart</u> retain my words; keep my commands, and live."</p>	<p>1:5</p>
<p><b>I need to earn my parent's trust.</b></p>	
<p><b>Proverbs 27:11</b> – My son, be wise, and make my heart glad, that I may answer him who <u>reproaches</u> me.</p> <p><b>Ephesians 6:1-2</b> – Children, <u>obey</u> your <u>parents</u> in the <u>Lord</u>, for this is <u>right</u>. "Honor your <u>father</u> and <u>mother</u>," which is the first <u>commandment</u> with <u>promise</u>.</p>	<p>1:6</p>
