

Easter Message

1. <i>3 dimes</i> represent the 30 pieces of silver paid to Judas for betraying Jesus.
2. <i>A whip</i> symbolizes how Jesus was beaten before Death.
3. <i>Thorns</i> show what the Crown of thorns was made of that Jesus wore.
4. <i>Purple cloth</i> for the purple robe that they made Him wear to mock him- Kings Robe.
5. <i>Cross</i> - Jesus had to carry this heavy cross to Calvary.
6. <i>Nails</i> - represent the Spikes driven into Jesus's hands and feet to put on Cross.
7. <i>Dice</i> - the soldiers gambled with them to get Jesus's clothes - Old T. said they would.
8. <i>Sponge</i> they gave Jesus vinegar (makes you thirstier) with it, when He was thirsty.
9. <i>Angels</i> rolled away the stone after Jesus was risen from the grave.
10. <i>Spear</i> used to make sure that Jesus was dead.
11. <i>White cloth</i> - what Jesus was buried in that held the spices.
12. <i>Stone</i> - over the tomb entrance was sealed and had a roman guard(4-16 soldiers) to make sure no one would steal Jesus's body and say He had risen.
13. <i>Emptiness</i> - shows how the grave was because Jesus rose on the third day.
