## Washington Monument

Steps have stones with inscriptions on them. Some of them are, "Search the Scriptures" – "Train up a child in the way he should go and when he is old he will not depart from it" –

"The memory of the just is blessed" – "Holiness to the Lord"

The top capstone made of aluminum says the top which says **Laus Deo** "Praise be to God!"

## Supreme Court building

Front Center Top (most important) shows Moses holding the **Ten Commandments** through which the voice of God thunders "Thou shalt not murder."

## 1891 The U.S. Supreme Court restates

*"Our laws and our institutions must necessarily be based upon and embody the teachings of the Redeemer of mankind. It is impossible that it should be otherwise; and in this sense and to this extent our civilization and our institutions are emphatically Christian ... this is a religious people. This is historically true. From the discovery of this continent to the present hour, there is a single voice making this affirmation ... we find everywhere a clear definition of the same truth ... this is a Christian nation."*

## Capitol Rotunda

Has **eight** massive oil **paintings**, each depicting a major event in history.

**Four** of these paintings portray Jesus Christ and the Bible
